The Teamsters-Ohio Contractors Association Health Plan and Ohio Conference of Teamsters & Industry Health Plan and its Board of Trustees and Fund Office (collectively, "we," "us," or "Plan") respect the privacy of our users ("user" or "you"). This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you use the Plans' website and member portal (the "Website"). Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH THE TERMS OF THIS PRIVACY POLICY, PLEASE DO NOT ACCESS THE WEBSITE.

We reserve the right to make changes to this Privacy Policy at any time and for any reason. We will alert you about any changes by updating the "Last updated" date of this Privacy Policy; the most recent version will always be available for you to review in the Website, or upon request to the Plans. You are encouraged to periodically review this Privacy Policy to stay informed of updates. You will be deemed to have notice of, will be subject to, and will be deemed to have accepted changes in any revised Privacy Policy by your continued use of the Website after the date such revised Privacy Policy is posted.

This Privacy Policy does not apply to the third-party online website from which you access the Website or to any links to other websites, applications, or advertisements displayed in the Website, which may also collect and use data about you. We are not responsible for any of the data collected by any such third party. COLLECTION OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may collect information about you in a variety of ways. The information we may collect via the Website depends on the content and materials you use, and may include:

- Personal Data, including demographic and other personally identifiable information (such as your name and email address) that you voluntarily give to us when using the Website and its features, which may include but is not limited to creating a profile, sending feedback, and using chat or messaging. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur and that the transferee may decline to honor commitments we made in this Privacy Policy.

We are not responsible for the actions of third parties with whom you share personal or sensitive data, and we have no authority to manage or control third-party solicitations. If you no longer wish to receive correspondence, emails or other communications from third parties, you are responsible for contacting the third party directly.

TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

Cookies and Web Beacons

We may use cookies, web beacons, tracking pixels, and other tracking technologies on the Website to help customize the Website and improve your experience. When you access the Website, your personal information is not collected through the use of tracking technology. Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default.
